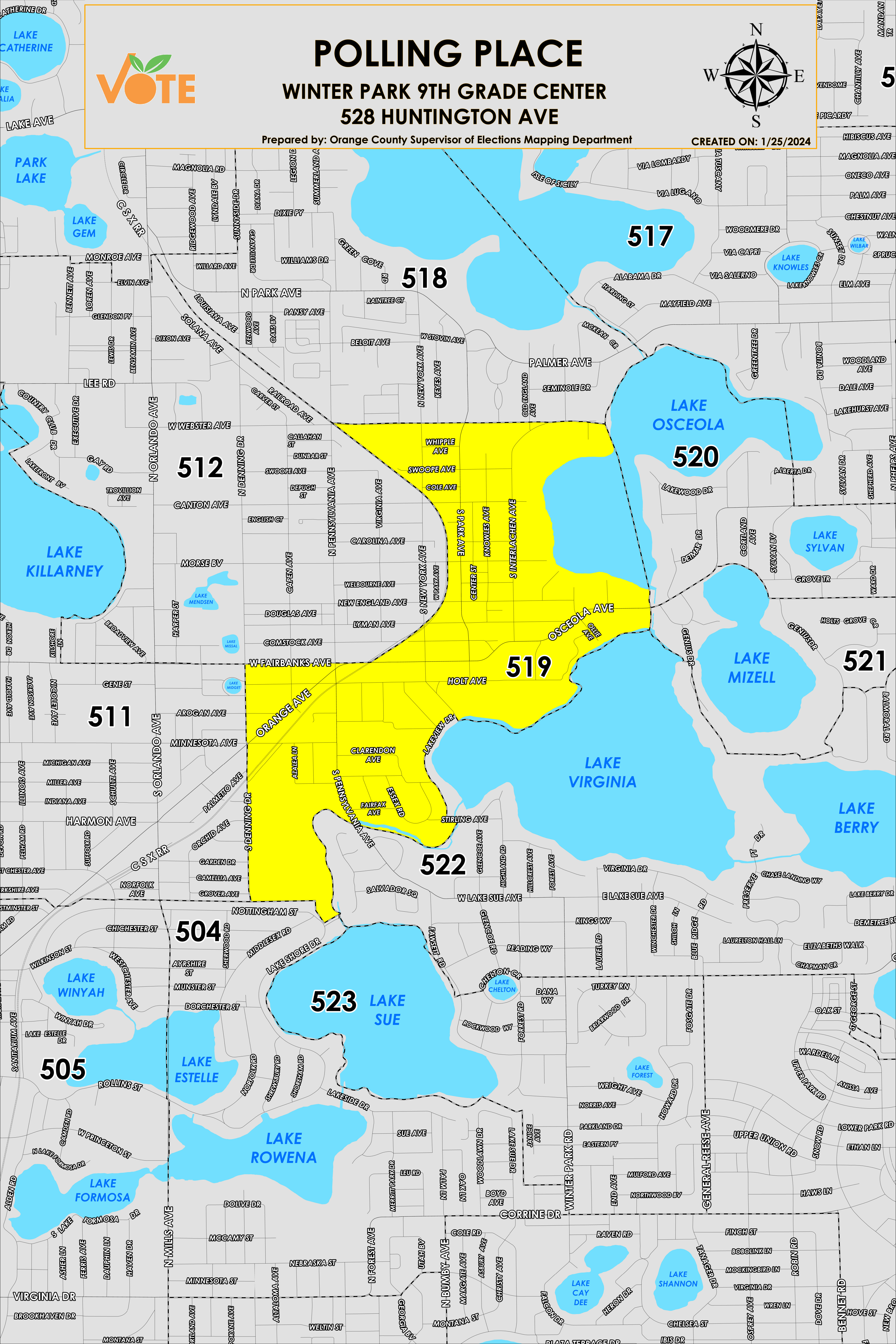

Precinct 519 (2024) northern boundary follows a combination of Webster Avenue and continues to West Fairbanks Avenue. The western boundary follows a combination east of North Virginia Avenue and West Park Avenue and continues to South Denning Drive. Avenue. The southern boundary follows a combination parallel north of Nottingham Street and Bonnie Burn Circle then continues along the northwestern shoreline of Lake Virginia. The eastern boundary follows a combination parallel west of Barcelona Way, Lakeview Drive and continues through the western section of Lake Osceola.

Precinct 519S is with district assignments of U.S. Congress 10, State Senate 10, State House 42, County Commission 5, and School Board 6.
