The meeting was called to order at 12:08 p.m.

Acknowledgement of Public Notification advertisement published in the Orlando Sentinel on March 23, 2016.

Meeting Minutes from March 18, 2016, Belle Isle City Council, Seat 3, Recount were viewed and accepted. **Steve Jewett, Chair, Alternate County Judge, made a motion to approve the Minutes. Bill Cowles, Supervisor of Elections seconded the motion. All voted in favor, motion approved.**

A request to appear or comment was received by Karl Shuck, Candidate, Belle Isle. Mr. Shuck questioned the period for appeal to Circuit Court to contest election results. The Canvassing Board advised Mr. Shuck of F.S. 102.168 for point of reference (Provided a copy of the Statute).
