## INTEGRATION OF MUNICIPAL AND COUNTY PRECINCTS

**101A65**

6-Character Precinct Code Break Down		
<b>County Commission District</b>	<b><u>Legacy County Precinct</u></b>	<b>Municipal Precinct</b>

Prior to the March 2020 Presidential Preference Primary, the legacy Elections Management System used by the Orange County Supervisor of Elections maintained County Precincts and Municipal Precincts separately. The current Election Management System only permits the maintenance of a single precinct structure and as such, the legacy County Precincts and legacy Municipal Precincts are integrated into a single structure. Note that election results are posted using the three digits of the Legacy County Precinct.

- 1) Legacy County Precincts are three digits. Legacy County Precincts occasionally contain a letter after the three-digit precinct number. This letter indicates one of the districts contained within the County Precinct and does not encompass the entire Precinct. County Precincts consist of the district assignments of County, State, and Federal districts:
  - a. Orange County Commission District (indicated by the first digit of the three digit precinct number)
  - b. U.S. Congressional District
  - c. State Senate District
  - d. State House District
  - e. School Board District
  - f. Special District
- 2) Legacy Municipal Precincts are four digits. These four digit Municipal Precincts include just the Municipal Precinct.
- 3) The new six-Character Precinct Code is an integration of the legacy County Precincts and the legacy Municipal Precincts into a single system. Neither the legacy County Precincts nor the legacy Municipal Precincts has changed, outside of regular Municipal Annexations. The new six-Character Precinct Code was created by an overlay of the two separate legacy precinct systems.
  - a. The first three digits of the six-Character Precinct Code are the legacy County Precinct Number.
  - b. The fourth character of the six-Character Precinct Code indicates a split of the legacy County Precinct. If no split in County, State, and Federal Districts exist: this character will be 'S'. If the fourth character is 'X', 'Y', or 'Z', a split exists, but the area contained within that area contains no voters, for example, a commercial area without residential addresses.
  - c. The final two digits of the six-Character Precinct Code indicates the Municipal Precinct. If the final two digits are '00,' the Precinct is Unincorporated.
    - i. A table showing the conversion of the legacy Municipal Precincts (left column) to their two-digit codes (right column) is included in this document.

# VISUALIZATION OF THE 6-CHARACTER PRECINCT CODE: PRECINCT 101

Precinct 101 is composed of:

Precinct 101A00 (Precinct 101A + UNINCORPORATED ORANGE COUNTY)

Precinct 101A65 (Precinct 101A + Municipal Precinct 65 [Legacy Orlando Municipal Precinct 6501])


Precinct 101B00 (Precinct 101B + UNINCORPORATED ORANGE COUNTY)

Precinct 101B65 (Precinct 101B + Municipal Precinct 65 [Legacy Orlando Municipal Precinct 6501])


The first four characters are the legacy County Precinct. If there is no split in the legacy County Precinct Structure, the fourth character is an 'S'. If there is a split in the Legacy County Precinct Structure, the fourth character is the sub-precinct letter that used in the legacy County Precinct.

The two digit Municipal Precinct can be found to the right of the legacy Municipal Precinct number in the table at the end of this document. If the area is not incorporated into a municipality, the Municipal Precinct for Unincorporated Orange County is 00.




Sub-Precincts 101A and 101B




Legacy Municipal Precinct 6501 (BLUE AREA)
