Primary Election – August 28, 2018  
General Election – November 6, 2018

Petition Process: County Offices 2018; County Mayor, County Commission Districts 2, 4, & 6, School Board Chair, School Board Districts 1, 2 & 3, Soil & Water Conservation District Supervisor & Special Districts.

After Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository has been filed - First day to begin collecting petitions, a DS/DE 9 must be on file. (Florida Statute 99.095 (2)(a))

May 21<sup>st</sup>, **NOON** – Last date to submit petitions to local Supervisor of Elections for verification, “28<sup>th</sup> day preceding the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

June 11<sup>th</sup> – Petitions must be certified by this date, “7<sup>th</sup> day before the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

June 18<sup>th</sup>, **NOON** through June 22<sup>nd</sup>, **NOON** - Candidate Qualifies with Supervisor of Elections office. Copy of Petition Certification along with all other qualifying documents to be filed. (No qualifying fee is required).

1% = **7,767** signatures.

**County Commission District 2** total registered voters 122,810, 1% = **1,228** signatures.

**County Commission District 4** total registered voters 138,237, 1% = **1,382** signatures.

**County Commission District 6** total registered voters 100,309, 1% = **1,003** signatures.

**School Board, District 1** total registered voters 112,391, 1% = **1,124** signatures.

**School Board, District 2** total registered voters 122,640, 1% = **1,226** signatures.

After Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository has been filed - First day to begin collecting petitions, a DS/DE 9 must be on file. (Florida Statute 99.095 (2)(a))

April 2<sup>nd</sup>, **NOON** – Last date to submit petitions to local Supervisor of Elections for verification, “28<sup>th</sup> day preceding the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

April 23<sup>rd</sup> – Petitions must be certified by this date, “7<sup>th</sup> day before the first day of the qualifying period for the office sought . . .” (Florida Statute 99.095 (3))

April 30<sup>th</sup>, **NOON** through May 4<sup>th</sup>, **NOON** - Candidate Qualifies with Supervisor of Elections office. Copy of Petition Certification along with all other qualifying documents to be filed. (No qualifying fee is required).
