## MESSAGE TO WINTER PARK VOTERS

On Tuesday, January 22, Orange County Elections staff discovered a data entry omission that resulted in incomplete election information being displayed for Winter Park voters. Winter Park voters who called the office to request a Vote-By-Mail ballot for the upcoming election may have been told incorrectly that they were not participating in the upcoming election. Corrections were made immediately upon discovery.

The City of Winter Park will hold a General Election for City Commission Seat Four on Tuesday, March 12, and if needed, a Run-Off election on April 9. ***This is an "at large" election, meaning all eligible Winter Park voters may participate.***

The registration deadline for new voters wanting to participate in this election is February 11. Voters can find registration application forms at the local Library or Post Office and on the Orange County Supervisor of Elections website at [www.ocfelections.com](http://www.ocfelections.com). Existing voters can verify their registration information through the website.

Official Sample Ballots are scheduled to be mailed on February 26 and will include polling place information. Additional information can be found on the Elections Office website or by calling (407) 836-VOTE (8683).

Winter Park voters have three convenient ways to vote – they can vote by mail, vote early at the Elections Office, or vote at their polling place on March 12. Vote-By-Mail ballots can be requested online or by calling the Elections Office. ***There's still plenty of time to request a Vote-By-Mail ballot as the initial mailing begins on February 5 and continues through March 6.*** Requests can be made either by calling the office at (407) 836-VOTE (8683) or online at [www.ocfelections.com](http://www.ocfelections.com). Voters can monitor the status of their Vote-By-Mail ballot through the website.

Early Voting is scheduled at the Orange County Elections Office, located at 119 W. Kaley Street in Orlando, from Monday, March 4 thru Friday, March 8 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Election Day polling places are open on Tuesday, March 12, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
