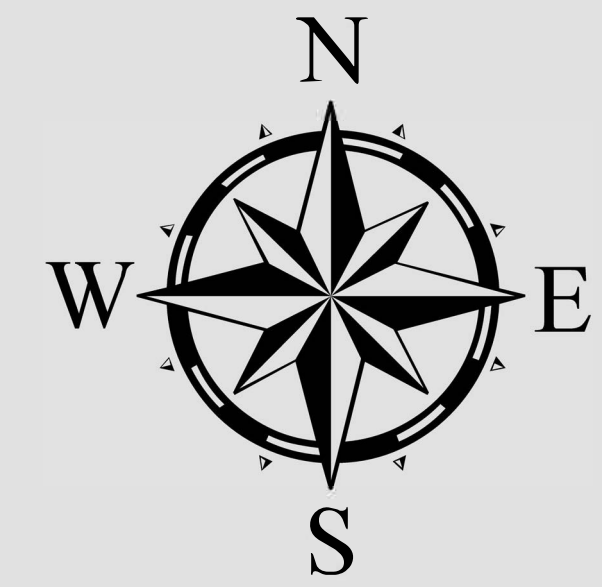




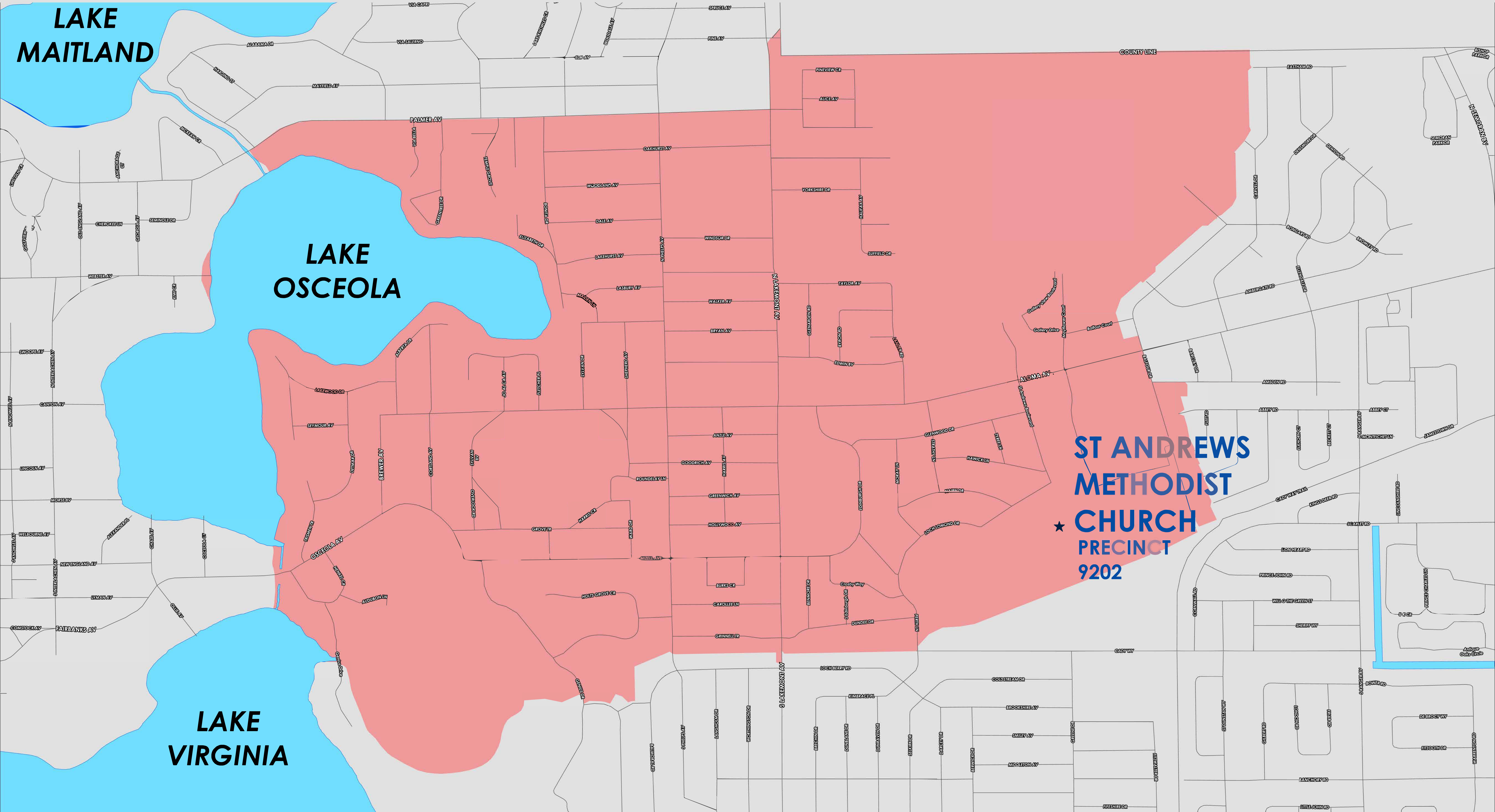

The City of Winter Park in Orange County, Florida has Five municipal precincts

WP16, WP17, WP18, WP19 and WP20.

LEGACY PRECINCT 9102 (Orange Color—WP16) 9202 (Red Color—WP17)

9302 (Green Color—WP18) 9402 (Purple Color—WP19) 9502 (Pink Color—WP20)

Municipal precinct **WP16** extends north from Palmer Ave. (southern border) to just north of Howell Branch Rd (northern boundary). East side of Lake Maitland is the western boundary and extends east to the Orange County boundary (eastern boundary).

Municipal precinct **WP17** is located to the south of Municipal Precinct WP16. This precinct extends south of Palmer Ave and Orange County boundary line to Loch Berry Rd. The western boundary runs along the west side of Lake Osceola and north side of Lake Virginia. The southern boundary runs along Loch Berry Rd, which is also Precinct WP18 northern border. The eastern border is Balfour Dr and extends across Aloma Ave up the Orange County border line.

Municipal precinct **WP18** is located to the south of Municipal Precinct WP17. This precinct extends north of Glenridge Wy, Barker Dr, Nash St and Baldwin Park St up to the WP17 southern boundary. The western boundary is Laurel Rd and Lake Virginia. Eastern boundary consists of Fairway Dr up to Cady Way Tr.

Municipal precinct **WP19** is located to the southwest of Municipal Precinct WP16. This precinct extends north of Fairbanks Ave (southern boundary) up to Monroe Ave, Sunnyside Dr and the southwest side of Lake Maitland. The eastern boundary runs along Interstate 4 and extends west to the west side of Lake Osceola and S Interlachen Ave. Portions of the southwest side of the precinct under Lake Killarney are unincorporated Orange County.

Municipal precinct **WP20** is located to the west of Municipal Precinct WP18. This precinct extends north and west of Corrine Dr and NE side of Lake Sue. The southern boundary continues along Nottingham St to the west up to Clay Ave. Western boundary starts on Clay Ave up to Kentucky Ave and ends at Little Lake Fairview. The northern boundary is WP17's southern boundary. Fairbanks Ave, S Interlachen Ave and the south side of Lake Osceola. East boundary consist of Lake Virginia's west side, travels along Laurel Rd, Glenridge Wy and General Reese Ave.

Within these borders there are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County (grey background), and not part of the City of Winter Park.

For the 2023 Municipal Elections, the City of Winter Park has Five polling places within municipal precincts.

The polling place for **WP16** is located at University Club, 841 N. Park Ave.

University Club is situated between N. Park Ave and Keyes Ave in precinct **WP19**.

The polling place for **WP17** is located at St. Andrews Methodist Church, 100 St. Andrews Blvd.

St. Andrews Methodist Church is situated between St. Andrews Blvd and Cady Wy.

The polling place for **WP18** is located at Winter Park Presbyterian Church, 400 S Lakemont Ave.

Winter Park Presbyterian Church is situated between Loch Berry Rd and Dundee Dr in Precinct **WP17**.

The polling place for **WP19** is located at 1st Baptist Church of Winter Park, 1021 N New York Ave.

1st Baptist Church of Winter Park is situated between Beloit Ave and Tantum Ave.

The polling place for **WP20** is located at Azalea Recreation Center, 1045 Azalea Ln.

Azalea Recreation Center is situated Barnum Ave and Azalea Ln.
