

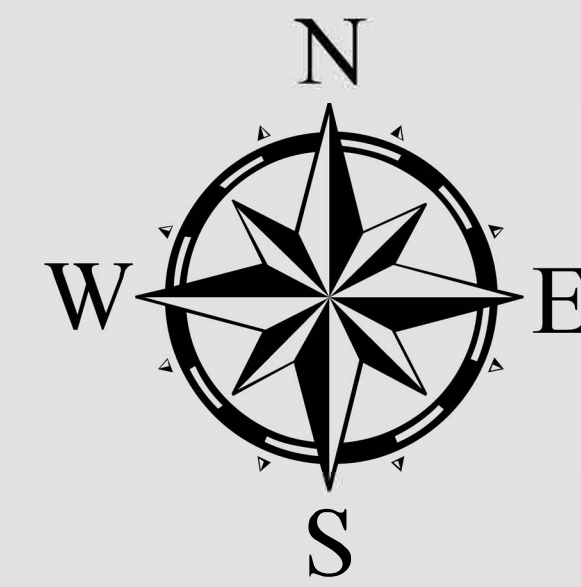

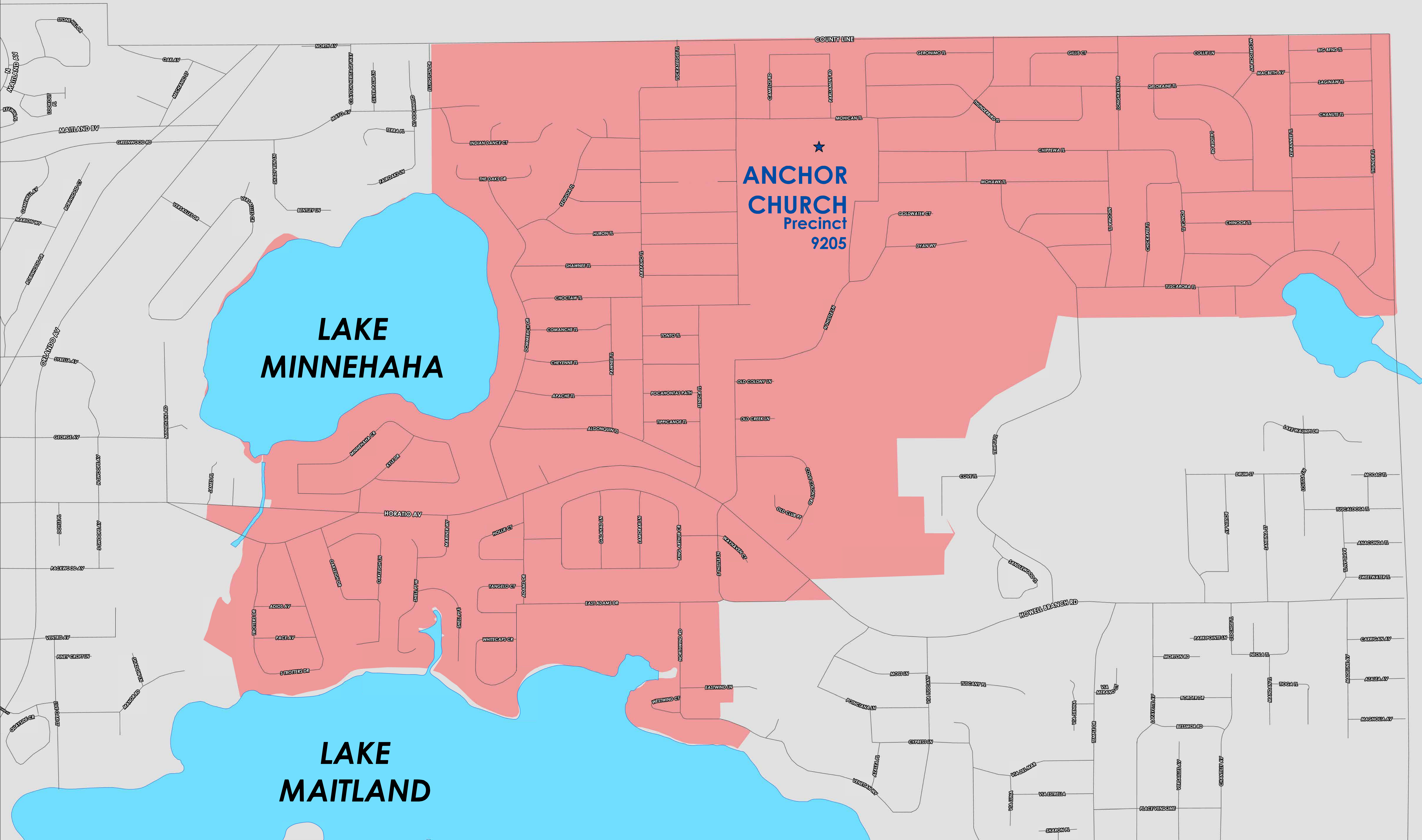

The City of Maitland in Orange County, Florida has two municipal precincts, MA21 and MA22.

LEGACY PRECINCT 9105 (Orange Color--MA21) and 9205 (Red Colo--MA22)

Municipal precinct MA21 extends north from the intersection of Glendon Parkway and Orlando Ave. (southern border) to Orange County border line (northern boundary). Just short of Forest City Rd is the start of the (western boundary) and extends east to the west side of Lake Minnehaha. (eastern boundary) This eastern boundary extends south along the west side of Lake Maitland onto Sunnyside Dr.

Municipal precinct MA22 is located to the East of Municipal Precinct MA21. This precinct extends north and west to the Orange County border line. The Southern Boundary runs along the northern side of Lake Maitland and then runs north prior to reaching Temple Trail. Prior to Tuscarora Trl the boundary extends east all the way to the Orange County border line.

Within these borders there are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County (grey background), and not part of the City of Maitland.

For the 2023 Municipal Elections, the City of Maitland has two polling places within municipal precincts.

The polling place for **MA21** is located at Maitland City Hall at 1776 Independence Ln.

Maitland City Hall is situated between S Maitland Ave and Independence Ln.

The polling place for **MA22** is located at Anchor Church at 1950 Mohican Trl.

Anchor Church is situated on the South side of Mohican Trl and West of N Thistle Ln.
