

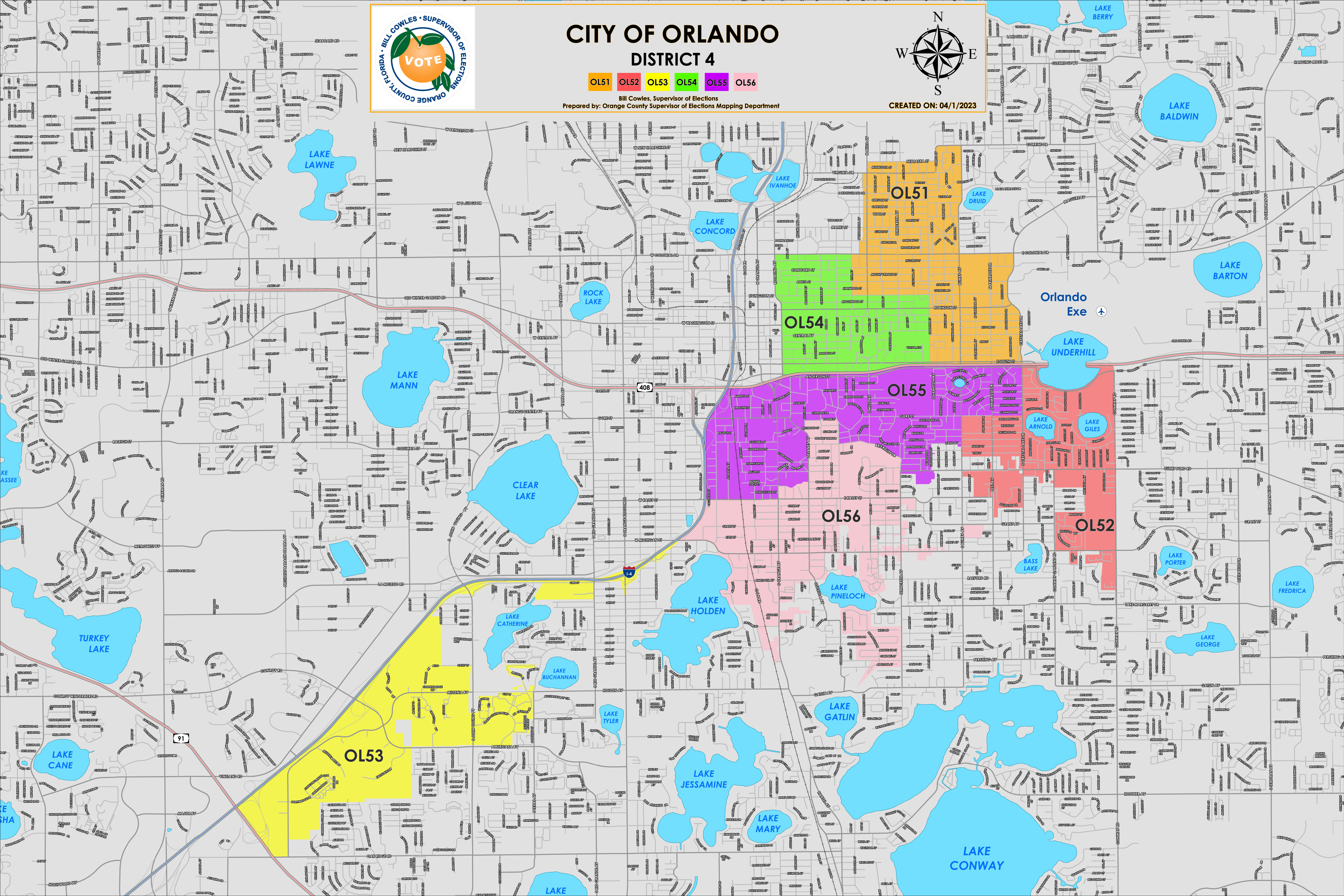
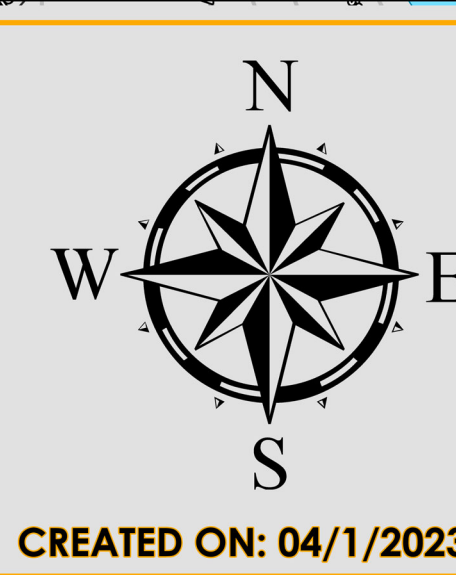

The City of Orlando District 4 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precincts OL51, OL52, OL53, OL54, OL55 and OL56.

District 4 approximately extends north to Nebraska Street and Corrine Drive, ends in the south at Oak Ridge Rd, American Blvd, Gatlin Ave and Lake Margaret Dr. Western boundary is Interstate 4, Rosalind Ave and N Mills Ave. Eastern boundary extends to Bumby Ave and Crystal Lake Dr. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando.
