

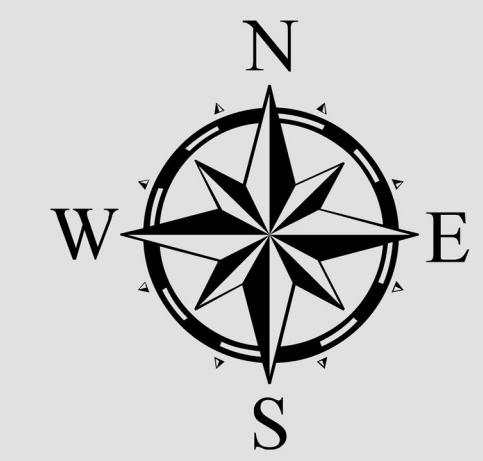

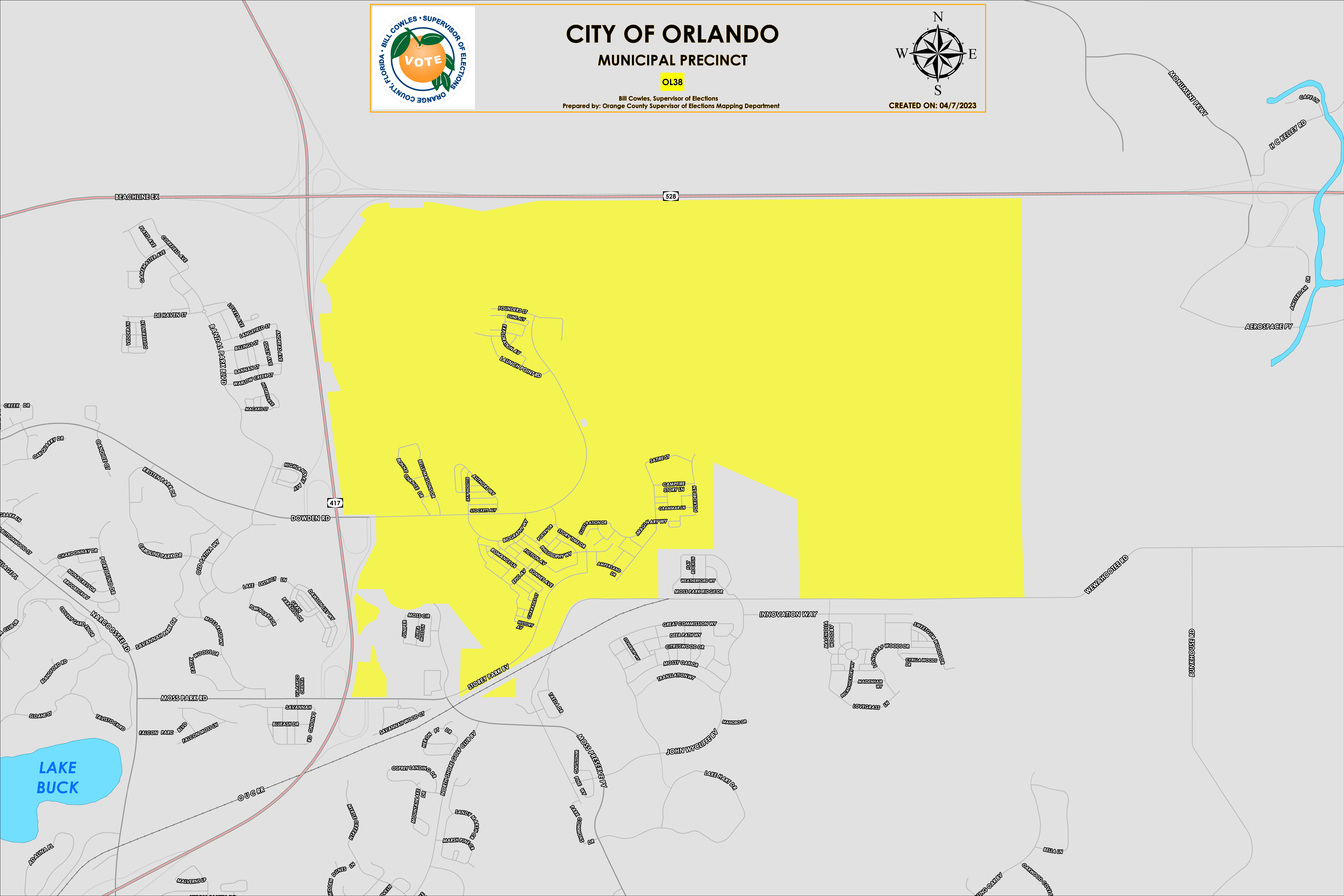

The City of Orlando District 1 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precincts 38.

Municipal precinct 38 extends north along State Road 528, west along State Road 417, south along Storey Park Blvd and Wewahootee Rd. The eastern boundary runs past Innovation Way up to State Road 528. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
