



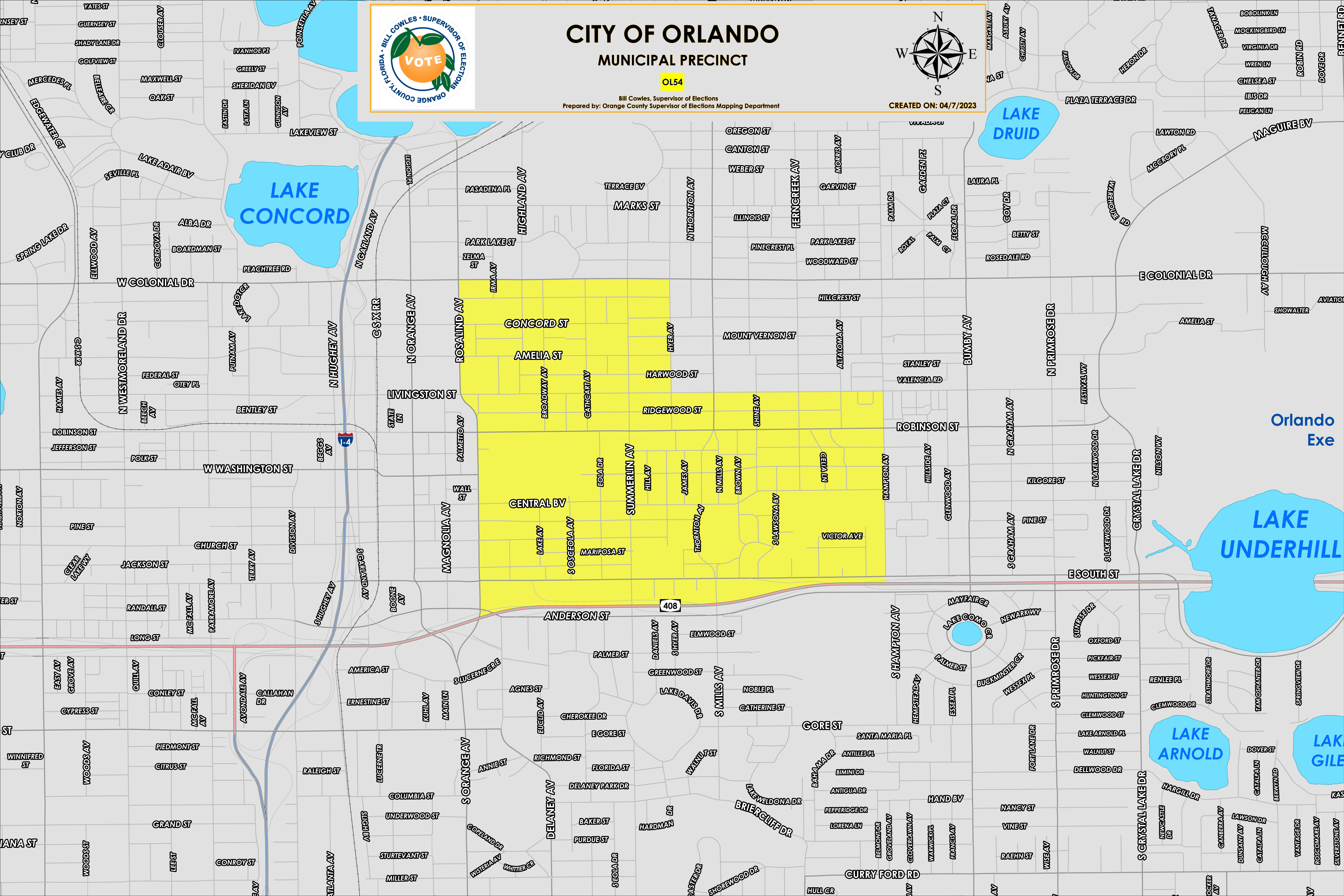
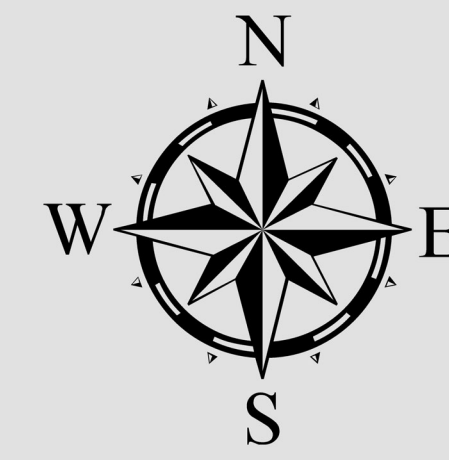

The City of Orlando District 4 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL54.

Municipal precinct OL54 approximately extends north to Colonial Drive, ends in the south at State Road 408, ends in the west at Rosalind Avenue, and ends in the east at Hampton Avenue. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

- 303
- 501
- 502

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
