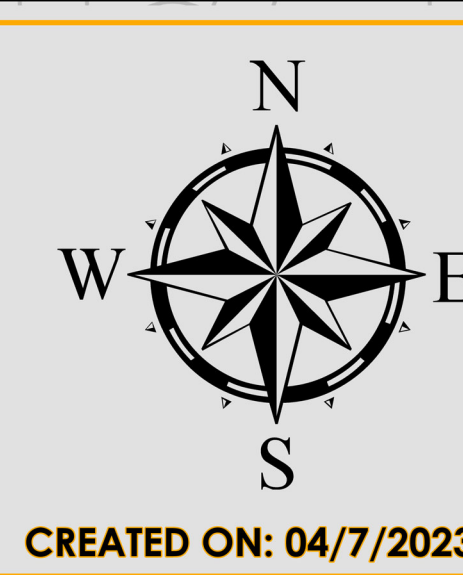




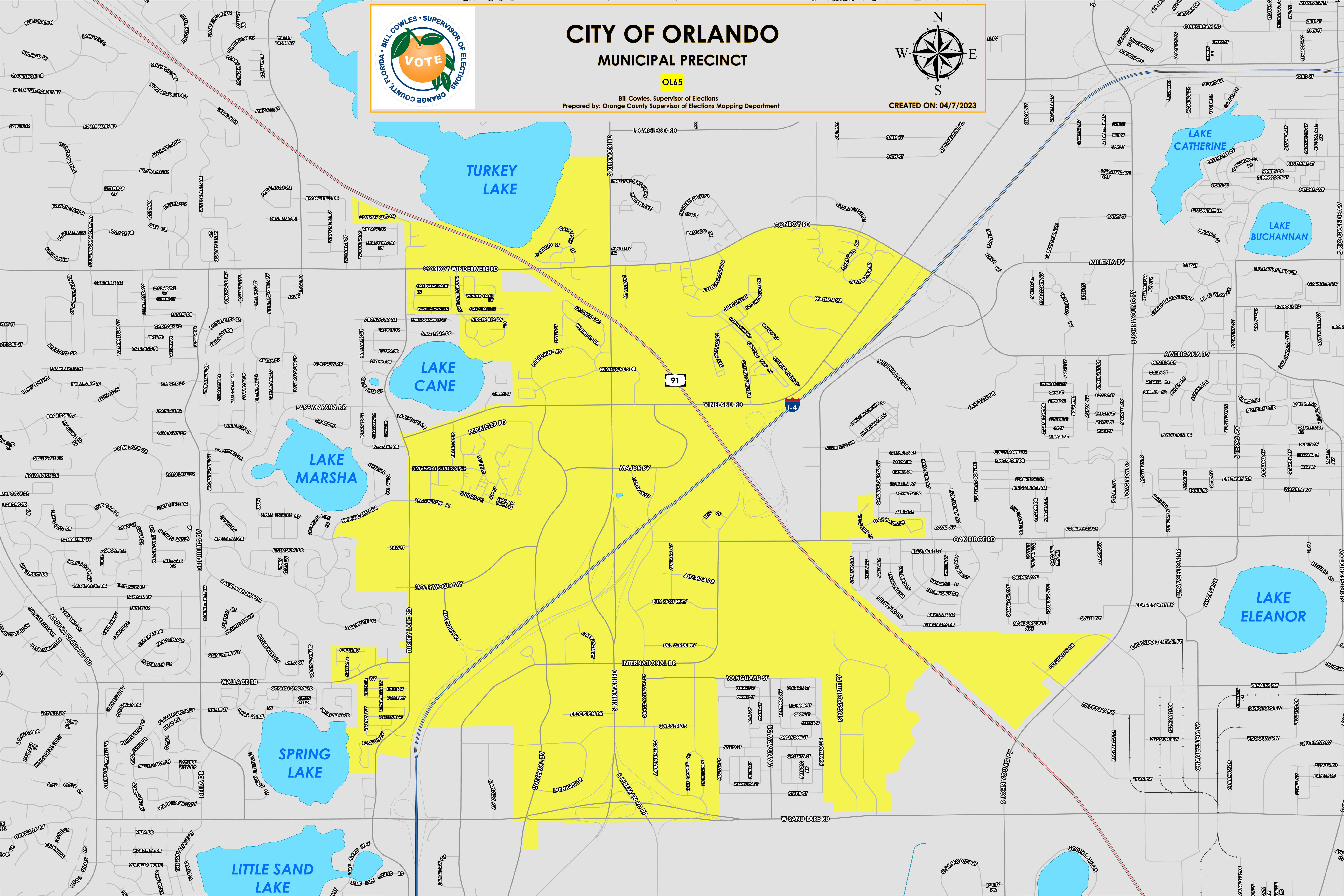

The City of Orlando District 6 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL65.

Municipal precinct OL65 approximately extends north to Conroy Road, east side of Turkey Lake and Florida Turnpike, ends in the south at Sand Lake Road, ends in the west at east side of Spring Lake and Turkey Lake Rd and Woodgreen Dr and ends in the east at South John Young Parkway an I-4. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
