

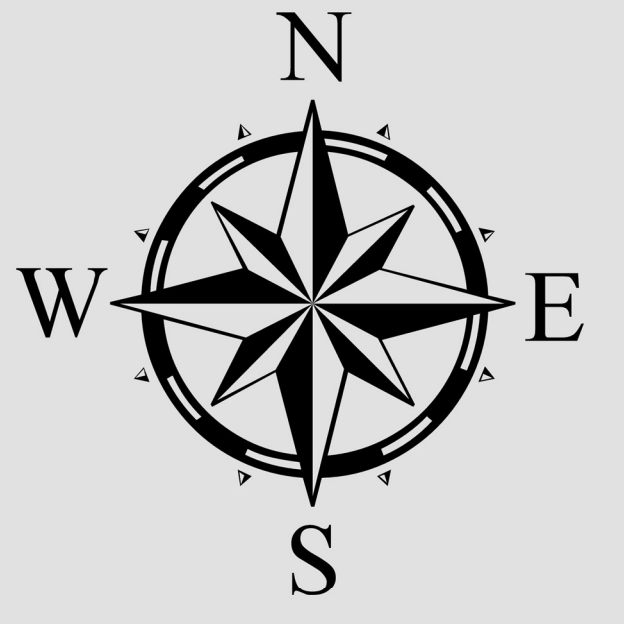

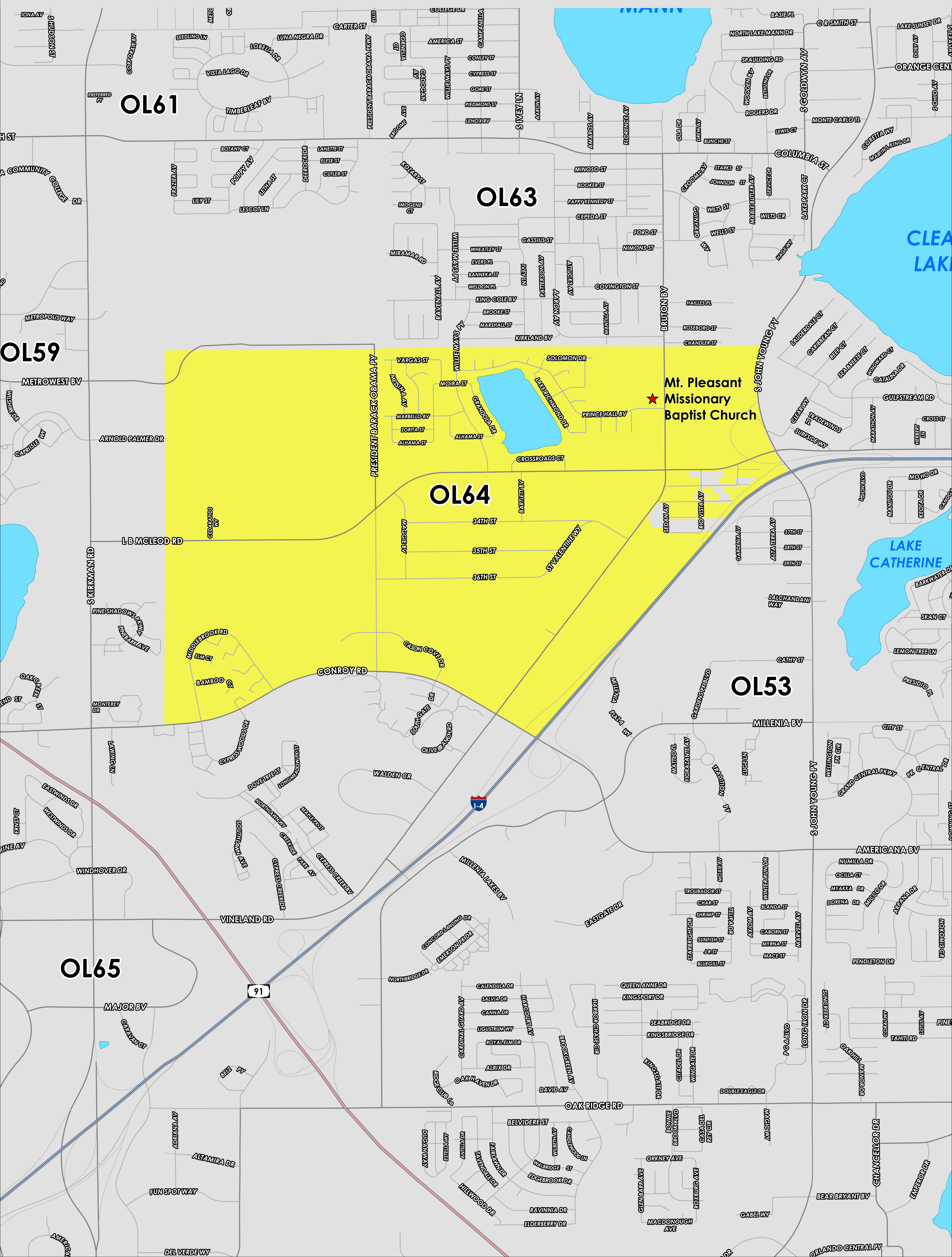

The City of Orlando District 6 in Orange County, Florida contains municipal precinct OL64.

Municipal precinct OL64 approximately extends north to Chandler Street, ends in the south at Conroy Road, and ends in the east at I-4 and S John Young Pkwy. The western boundary ends just west of Middlebrook Road. Within these borders are many sections which are considered unincorporated Orange County, and not part of the City of Orlando. This municipal precinct also includes the following Orange County precincts:

The polling place for OL64 is located at Mt. Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church, 4077 Prince Hall Blvd.

Mt. Pleasant Missionary Baptist Church is situated at the corner of Bruton Blvd and Prince Hall Blvd in precinct OL64.

Each listed Orange County precinct is partially made up of the City of Orlando and partially unincorporated Orange County, which change according to municipal annexation ordinances.
